It's Spring! This term we decided to email class teachers about what class texts they're reading - see if you can find your year group's text!

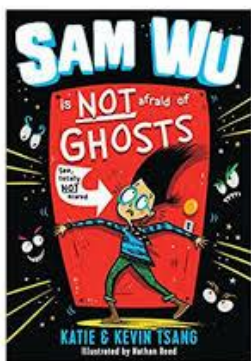

Question-What is your favourite book ?

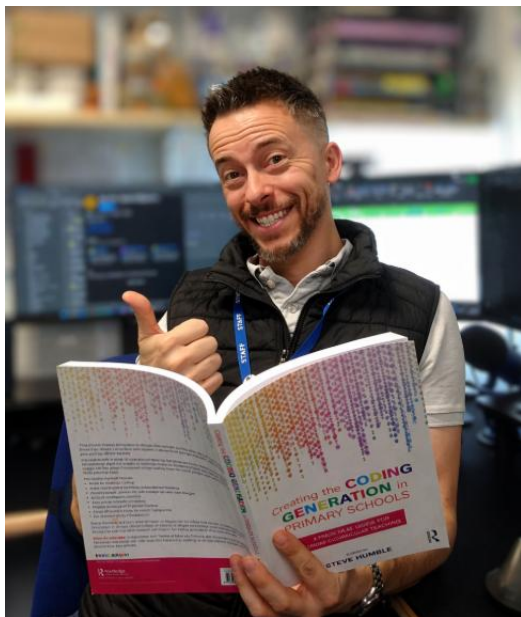
Answer- "Roald Dahl : *George's Marvellous Medicine.*"

Roald Dahl:

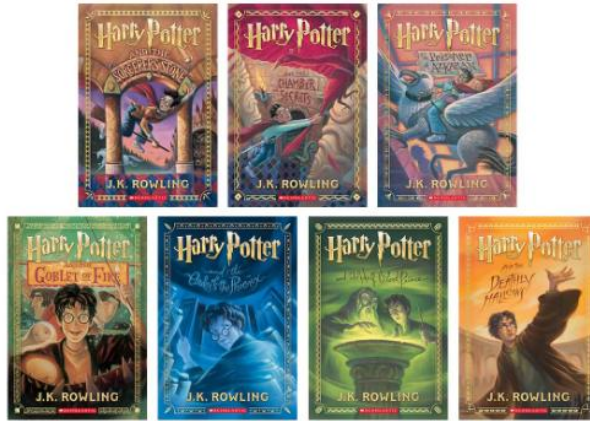
Imaginative stories, including *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* and *Matilda*.

A British author known for writing real-life situations in books like *The Story of Tracy Beaker*.

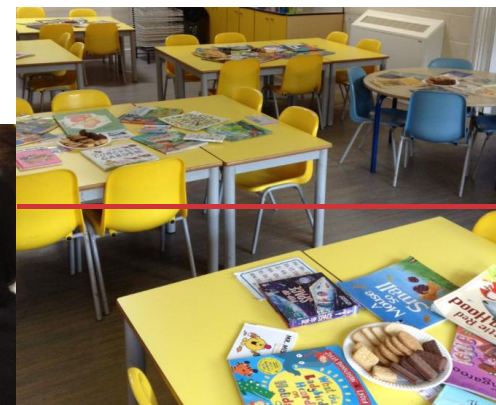
Next term's reading event:
